EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Caravan 28 State Com No. 701H Well** (API No. Pending) to be completed within the WC-025 G-09 S243336I; Upper Wolfcamp Pool (Pool Code 98092) underlying the E/2W/2 of Sections 28 and 33, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This well will be drilled from a surface location 546 feet from the north line and 2,153 feet from the west line (Unit C) of Section 28. The upper most perforation will be located 100 feet from the north line and 2,490 feet from the west line (Unit C) of Section 33. Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox because it is approximately 150 feet to the eastern boundary of the spacing unit. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will allow EOG to use their preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells in this area and thereby prevent waste.

**Exhibit A** is a Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the completed interval of the proposed **Caravan 28 State Com No. 701H Well** encroaches on the tracts to the east. This well has not yet been drilled.

**Exhibit B** is a land plat for Sections 28 and 33 and the surrounding sections that shows the proposed **Caravan 28 State Com No. 701H Well** in relation to adjoining units and existing wells. This exhibit also shows EOG's well spacing pattern for the subject area.

**Exhibit C** is a list of the parties affected by the encroachment to the East. The W/2E/2 and the E/2W/2 of Sections 28 and 33 are covered by a joint operating agreement. However, ownership is diverse between the subject spacing unit and the tracts to the East. Each of the parties listed on
