BOPCO, L.P. (OGRID 260737) is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production and off-lease measure from the Indian Flats; Delaware Pool (Pool code: 33735) from the following diversely owned federal leases located in Township 21 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico:

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Big Eddy Well No. 74 Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in Unit B, Section 25, Township 21 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Production from the subject wells shall be determined as follows:

Oil and gas production from all wells in this application shall be measured with a combination of metering and well testing.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 19.15.12.10.C NMAC and 19.15.4.12.A (8) NMAC.

It is also understood that you have given due notice of this application to all owners in the mineral interest estate ("affected parties") as defined in Rule 19.15.12.10.C (4) NMAC.

The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

Subsequent wells within leases approved by this order may be added to this administrative surface commingle application with a Sundry notice to the Engineering Bureau.

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

This administrative order supersedes order CTB-615-B, issued on June 27, 2011. This amended order adds the North Indian Flats 24 Well No. 15.

This administrative order is subject to like approval from the Bureau of Land Management.

The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
