Reference is made to your application dated June 29, 1967, for authority to set a whipstock above the Mesaverde formation and to intentionally deviate your Hubbard Well No. 2, located 990 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 11, Township 32 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, to be recompleted as a dual in the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin-Dakota Gas Pools.

Pursuant to Order No. R-3031, as amended by Order No. 3031-A, Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits in triplicate, its application for approval for the intentional deviation of a well previously drilled to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico.

In support of this application, Applicant respectfully states and shows the following:

- 1. The well to be deviated is the Aztec-Hubbard No. 2 Well, located 990 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 11, Township 32 North, Range 12 West, San Juan County, New Mexico. The proration unit for the well is the $S^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of said Section 11, being more particularly described as Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, S SEL and the SSWL. The well was originally completed open hole in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool in August, 1951.
- 2. Applicant now proposes to set a whipstock above the Mesaverde producing interval, intentionally deviate and re-drill to the Mesaverde and Dakota formation and dually complete the well in both zones.
- 3. The well will be so drilled and such deviation tests conducted as may be necessary to ensure that the well is bottomed no nearer than 200 feet to the outer boundary of its proration unit.
- 4. Such proposed operation will prevent waste and protect correlective rights.


