Dear Sir:

Reference is made to your request of January 10, 1986 to increase the surface injection pressure on your Myers Langlie Mattix Unit No. 128 Well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on the well on September 4, 1985. The results of the test have been reviewed and we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time. It is our policy, however, to allow a pressure equal to 50 psi below fracture pressure.

You are therefore authorized to increase your surface injection pressure on the following well:
