Reference is made to your request dated June 1, 1988, to increase the surface injection pressure on 4 wells within the North Vacuum Abo Unit Waterflood Project. This request is based on step rate tests conducted on these wells on May 25 and 26, 1988. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on these wells is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following wells.
