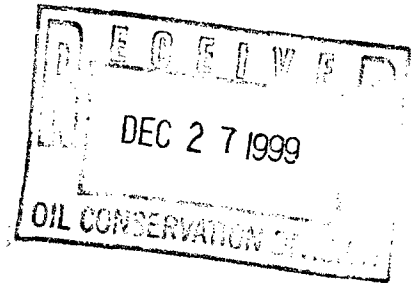

CALCULATIONS FOR MORRIS A #13 MV-CHACRA

Commingled
Blanco Mesaverde
Otero Chacra

The Mesaverde has been producing since 1/86.

The Mesaverde has a cumulative of 723 MMCF and 1,302 BO.

The Mesaverde capacity before the Chacra was opened was about 125 MCF/D and a trace of oil.

Completion date of the workover to open the Chacra and commingle with the MV on 9/7/99.

First delivery of commingled Chacra-MV on 9/24/99.

Total Chacra and MV rate after about 3 months on line: 280 MCF/D and a trace of oil.

GAS ALLOCATION

Mesaverde = $125/280 = 45\%$

Chacra = $(280-125)/280 = 55\%$
