Your application to downhole commingle the production from within the wellbore of the above-captioned well was received on May 20, 1999. Your application requests our approval to downhole commingle the Blinebry, Tubb, and Drinkard production within the wellbore of the State "C" Tract 13 Well No. 5, Unit Letter E, located in Section 36-21S-37E, Lea County, New Mexico.
