Pursuant to Division Rule 104.F(2), Mewbourne Oil Company applies for approval of an unorthodox oil well location for the following well:

<u>Well:</u>	Geronimo "30" Fed. Well No. 3
<u>Location:</u>	1980 feet FNL & 1515 feet FWL
<u>Well Units:</u>	SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico


The well will be drilled to a depth (9300 feet) sufficient to test the Bone Spring formation (North Lusk-Bone Spring Pool). The pool is spaced on 40 acres, with wells to be no closer than 330 feet to a quarter-quarter section line. A Form C-102 for the well is attached as Exhibit A.

The well's location is based upon topographic reasons. The well is in a sand dune area, and the location was moved west of a standard location, at the request of the BLM, to avoid sand dunes and destruction of potential sand dune lizard habitat. The location is also satisfactory to the archaeologist. See Exhibit B.

The entire NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30 is covered by Federal Lease NM 9016, and leasehold ownership (royalty, working, and overriding royalty) is common as to the Bone Spring formation. Therefore, there is no adversely affected interest owner, and notice of this application has not been given to anyone.

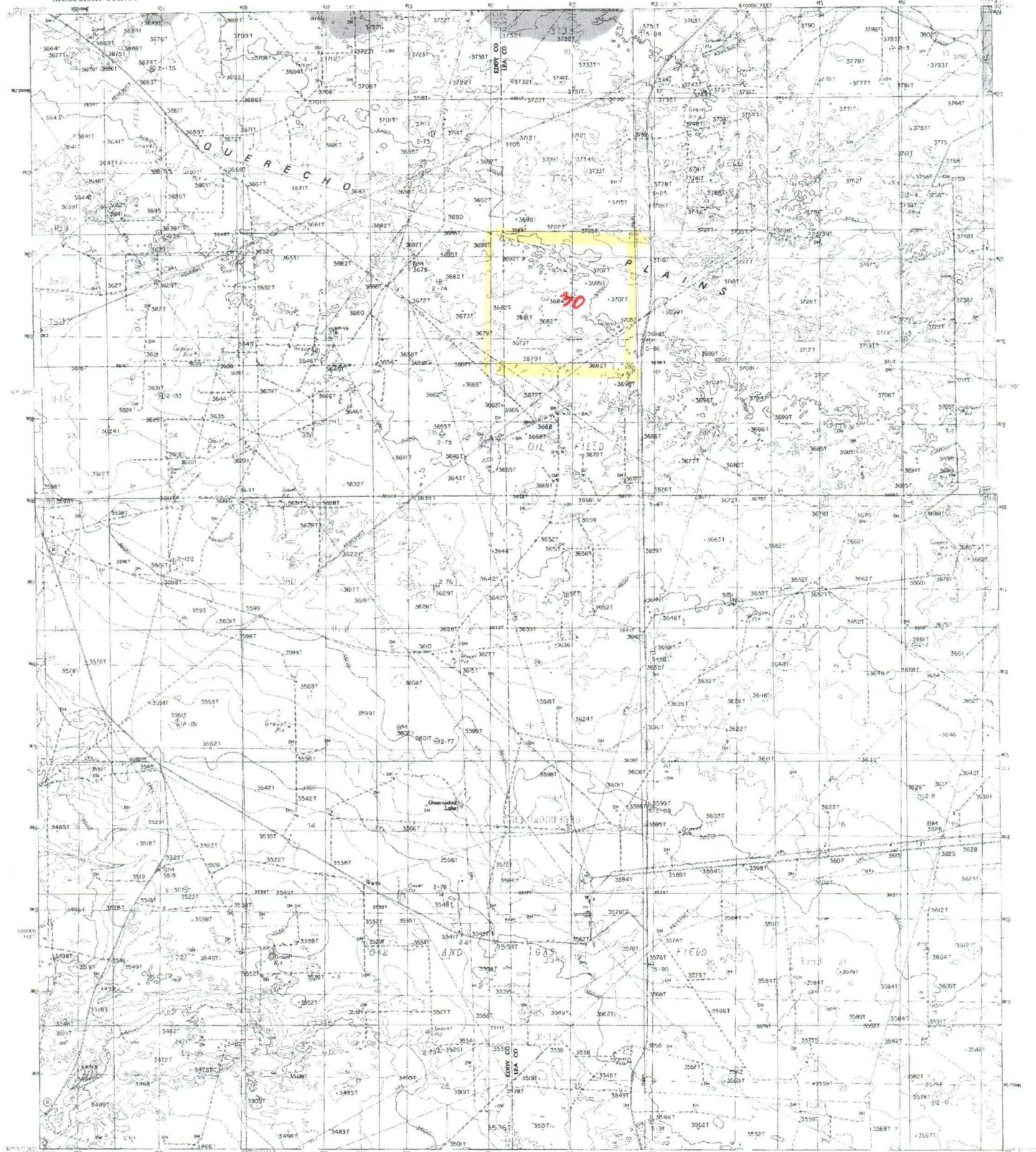
