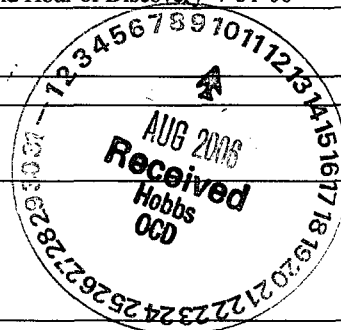

During a routine inspection personnel discovered a leak where a tank had been seeping. Xeric contacted Allstate Environmental Services to remediate. We viewed the site and provided a remedial action plan.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*  
AES would like to excavate the impacted area and take bottom and side wall samples to determine that all impacted soil has been excavated. The excavated material will be placed on plastic at the site and mixed and blended until acceptable levels are reached. Once laboratory confirmation is obtained of the stockpiled material, the remediated soil will then be replaced. (See Remedial Action Plan)X
