The proposed well is for a dual completion in the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) and East Blanco-PC Pools. Your application however is for just the Fruitland interval. Is the notification sufficient to cover the PC interval so that I can issue one order for both zones?

Also, on OCD Form C-103 dated 2/27/2006 for Burlington's proposed San Juan 29-7 Unit #549-S (API No. 30-039-29427) to have been drilled at a standard gas well location for both the Fruitland and PC intervals 1640' FSL & 1880' FWL (K) Sec. 9-T29N-R7W, it states "[P] lease cancel the APD for this location. The Well was moved to avoid the FEE surface and subsequently now is located on BLM land and a BLM APD has been permitted." You failed to mention, much less cover the reasoning behind this cancelation and move. Please do so now and don't spare the details.

I am in receipt of your email dated 6/1/06, concerning my NSL application on the above referenced well. I apologize for being unclear on my application with regard to the Blanco Pictured Cliff formation. The Pictured Cliff formation is within the PC participating area and is therefore standard at this staked location, as shown on the attached participating area plat. However, the certified copies were mistakenly forwarded to PC working interest owners also.

I have researched the previous APD submitted and cancelled under the same name and have found the original location was moved due to surface owner's request. The original well was staked too close to Fidel Candelaria's house and barn, as shown on the attached aerial photography map.

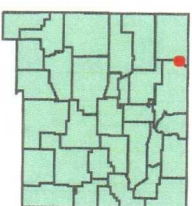
