AMENDED AGREED COMPLIANCE ORDER

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 3 of Agreed Compliance Order 107 (hereinafter "Order"), the Director of the Oil Conservation Division ("OCD") hereby amends that Order as follows:

FINDINGS

- 1. The Order requires Occidental Permian Ltd. ("Operator") to return to compliance with OCD Rule 201 at least 8 of the wells identified in Exhibit A and B by August 10, 2006, and file a compliance report by that date.
- 2. The Order further provides that if Operator returns to compliance with OCD Rule 201 at least 8 of the wells identified in Exhibits A and B by August 10, 2006, and files a timely compliance report, the OCD shall issue an amendment extending the terms of the Order for an additional twelve-month period, requiring Operator to return to compliance by February 10, 2007 any wells identified on Exhibits A and B still operated by Operator that remain out of compliance.
- 3. Operator filed a timely compliance report, and the OCD has verified that OCD records indicate that Operator has returned the following wells identified in Exhibits A and B to compliance:

CONCLUSIONS

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- 1. Operator has exceeded by 2 wells its goal of returning 8 of the wells identified in Exhibits A and B to compliance by August 10, 2006.
- 2. The OCD should amend the Order to extend its terms through August 10, 2007 and require Operator to return to compliance by that date any wells identified on Exhibits A and B still operated by Operator that remain out of compliance.

ORDER

- 1. Operator shall return to compliance by August 10, 2007 any wells identified on Exhibits A and B still operated by Operator that remain out of compliance.
- 2. Operator shall file a compliance report by August 10, 2007 using the Oil Conservation Division's web-based on-line application.
- 3. The terms of Agreed Compliance Order 107 otherwise remain in effect and are extended through August 10, 2007.
