I have reviewed my files on these cases and time sheets for the last year + and this is the history of these applications as reflected therein.

I filed these applications for administrative approval in July 2005. We met and they were returned to me and sent to the district for handling. Thereafter it appears that Williams talked to Steve Hayden and obtained approval to drill from the BLM -- though not from the OCD -- and drilled all three wells. In May 2006, Charlie Perrin called Williams and advised that the wells were not properly permitted and had to be shut in - which I understand they did. On June 5th, I met briefly with you and we agreed these cases should go to hearing. On June 6th, I filed legal advertisements and sent out notice letters for July 6th hearing. On June 9th I wrote Fesmire and requested permission to leave the wells on pending action on the applications. I copied the letter to you. (I believe that I went to him because you told me that was something that I would have to pursue with him -- although I may be wrong on this.) Fesmire called me on June 9th and told me that on review of the applications they would not have to go to hearing and that I should resubmit applications with a copy to Aztec. I had assumed that you were aware of this. I resubmitted the applications on June 12th and on the 14th Ocean called Charlie Perrin to confirm he had copies of the new administrative applications. I dismissed the cases by letter dated June 29th. I have not even thought about this matter until your calls yesterday and today. I will call you this afternoon to discuss further. Bill


