## <u>AMENDED</u> AGREED COMPLIANCE ORDER

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph of Agreed Compliance Order 117 ("ACOI 117" or "Order"), the Director of the Oil Conservation Division ("OCD") hereby amends that order as follows:

#### FINDINGS

1. ACOI 117 requires Paladin Energy Corp. ("Operator") to return to compliance with OCD Rule 201 at least four of the wells identified in ACOI 117 by September 20, 2006, and file a compliance report by that date.

2. ACOI 117 further provides that if Operator returns to compliance with OCD Rule 201 at least four of the wells identified in ACOI 117 by September 20, 2006, and files a timely compliance report, the OCD shall issue an amendment extending the terms of ACOI 117 for an additional six-month period, requiring Operator to return an additional four wells to compliance by that deadline.

3. Operator filed a timely compliance report, and the OCD has verified that Operator has returned the following wells identified in ACOI 117 to compliance:

1. Howard Fleet #005	30-025-30855
2. Lowe #001	30-025-30702
3. New Mexico BH State #001	30-025-08007
4. State C #003	30-025-34239
5. WW Hamilton A #002	30-025-12485
6. WE Mathers A #002	30-025-01048

4. The following wells identified in ACOI 117 remain out of compliance:

1.	CW Robinson #001	30-025-00053
2.	New Mexico BH State #002	30-025-08008
3.	New Mexico C State #002	30-025-05097
4.	State EC C #001	30-025-00104

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## CONCLUSIONS

1. Operator has returned six of the wells identified in ACOI 117 to compliance, exceeding its four-well goal by two wells.

2. The OCD should amend ACOI 117 to extend its terms through March 20, 2007 and require Operator to return to compliance by March 20, 2007 at least two of the wells identified in Findings Paragraph 4 above to meet its four-well goal for this second period.

### ORDER

1. Operator shall return to compliance by March 20, 2007 at least two of the wells identified in Findings Paragraph 4 above to meet its four-well goal for this second period.

2. Operator shall file a compliance report by March 20, 2007 using the Oil Conservation Division's web-based on-line application.

3. The terms of ACOI 117 otherwise remain in effect.
