## AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER DHC-2749

Lakeshore Federal "10" Com No. 2 API No. 30-015-29879 Unit I, Section 10, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Undesignated Avalon Upper-Pennsylvanian (Gas –71000), West Burton Flat-Strawn (Gas – 73440), and Avalon-Morrow (Gas – 70920) Pools

Dear Mr. Merrill:

Reference is made to your recent application for an amendment to Division Order No. DHC-2749 dated June 21, 2000, which order authorized the commingling of West Burton Flat-Strawn and Avalon-Morrow Gas Pool production within the well, to add the Avalon Upper-Pennsylvanian Pool as a third commingled pool in the well.

It appearing that the subject well qualifies for approval for such amendment pursuant to the provisions of Rule 303.C., and that reservoir damage or waste will not result from such downhole commingling, and correlative rights will not be violated thereby, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production as described above and any Division Order which authorized the dual completion and required separation of the zones is hereby placed in abeyance.

The maximum amount of gas which may be produced daily from the well shall be determined by Division Rules and Regulations or by the gas allowable for each respective prorated pool as printed in the Division's Southeast Gas Proration Schedule.

Assignment of allowable to the well and allocation of production from the well shall be on the following basis:

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West Burton Flat-Strawn Gas Pool	Oil-0%	Gas-12%
Avalon Upper-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool	Oil-78%	Gas-20%
Avalon-Morrow Gas Pool	Oil-22%	Gas-68%

REMARKS: The operator shall notify the Artesia District Office of the Division upon implementation of the commingling process.

Pursuant to Rule 303.C.(2), the commingling authority granted herein may be rescinded by the Division Director if conservation is not being best served by such commingling.
