Dear Ms. Carlson:

I have reviewed your recent application to downhole commingle the Abo, Blinebry, Tubb and Drinkard formations within the Kyte Well No. 1, and I have determined that additional data will be required before this application can be processed. Please submit the following additional data, at which time your application will be processed.

- a) Pool <u>names</u> and pool <u>codes</u>;
- b) Accurate oil gravities;
- c) All data on the Tubb interval;
- d) Accurate C-102 Data (C-102's reflect Kyte Well No. 190)
- e) List of working, royalty and overriding royalty interest owners to whom notice was provided of this application;
- f) Production curve for each zone for at least one year (if not available, attach explanation);
- g) Data to support allocation method or formula.

The Division is especially concerned about the data on which you based the recommended allocation of production. Your application states that these percentages are based upon one hour tests. Please elaborate fully on this point and present any additional

information that may verify the accuracy of your recommended allocation. In the case of non-common interest ownership between the zones to be commingled, it is imperative that the allocation of production be as accurate as possible in order to protect correlative rights.
