This letter acknowledges the receipt of your administrative application dated August 2, 2001, to downhole commingle the the Strawn and Atoka formations in the Jaguar "26" Federal Well No. 1 located in Section 26, Township 20 South, Range 21 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The Division received your application on August 7, 2001.

Our preliminary review indicates that the information provided in the application is not sufficient to process the administrative order. The following information is necessary:

- a) **Administrative Application Checklist**
- b) **A description of the method by which production shall be allocated to each of the commingled zones and supporting data.**

Since the submitted information is insufficient to review, the application was **Ruled Incomplete** on August 14, 2001. Please submit the above stated information by August 21, 2001.
