WORK PLAN

General:

Leak occurred 10/30/2006, losing salt water & oil. The fluid was picked up and work began to stabilize area. Approximately 1400 sq. ft. of ground was affected.

The OCD and BLM were notified.

Groundwater:

According to State Engineer and Groundwater information, the depth of water occurs at approximately 325 feet below the surface.

Remediation Proposal:

Area was stabilized by mixing soil with fluids. Our cleanup will be to excavate contaminated soil, haul to an OCD approved facility and replace with clean soil and seed. Before backfilling, the area will be tested for TPH and chloride to assure we meet OCD guidelines, and only after OCD approves, we will backfill and level.

The OCD will be notified of all activities and a report will be filed upon completion.

Ranking Criteria Score - 0

This site has a 5000 ppm TPH cleanup and will cleanup BTEX and Chloride per OCD.
