Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a non-standard location for your Callow-Federal Well No. 7, located 2110' from the North line and 530' from the East line of Section 28, Township 29 North, Range 13 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, in the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool.

It is our understanding that the request for such exception is based upon the extreme topographic relief in the NE/4 of Section 28.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Order R-566, Rule 6-b of the Special Rules and Regulations for the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool you are hereby granted an exception to the normal spacing requirements for your Callow-Federal Well No. 7.
