Dear Mr. Macey:

As Operator of the Northeast Blanco Unit, we request permission to drill an unorthodox well, to be located 420' from the South line and 2515' from the East line of Section 17, T 30 N, R 7 W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The normal location is situated in the San Juan River Canyon which eliminates this location because it would not be above the lake level of the Navajo Dam Project. Therefore, it is necessary to select a more suitable location for a drilling site.

Section 17, T 30 N, R 7 W, is a part of the Northeast Blanco Unit and the new location, as requested, will present no drainage problem.

We enclose a location plat of the requested new location and a plat of the Northeast Blanco Unit.

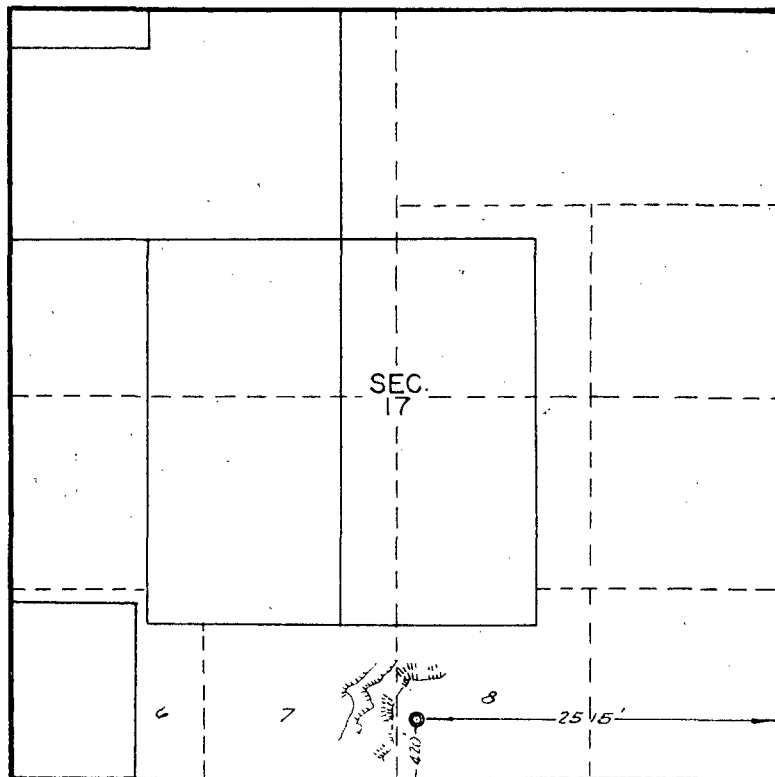

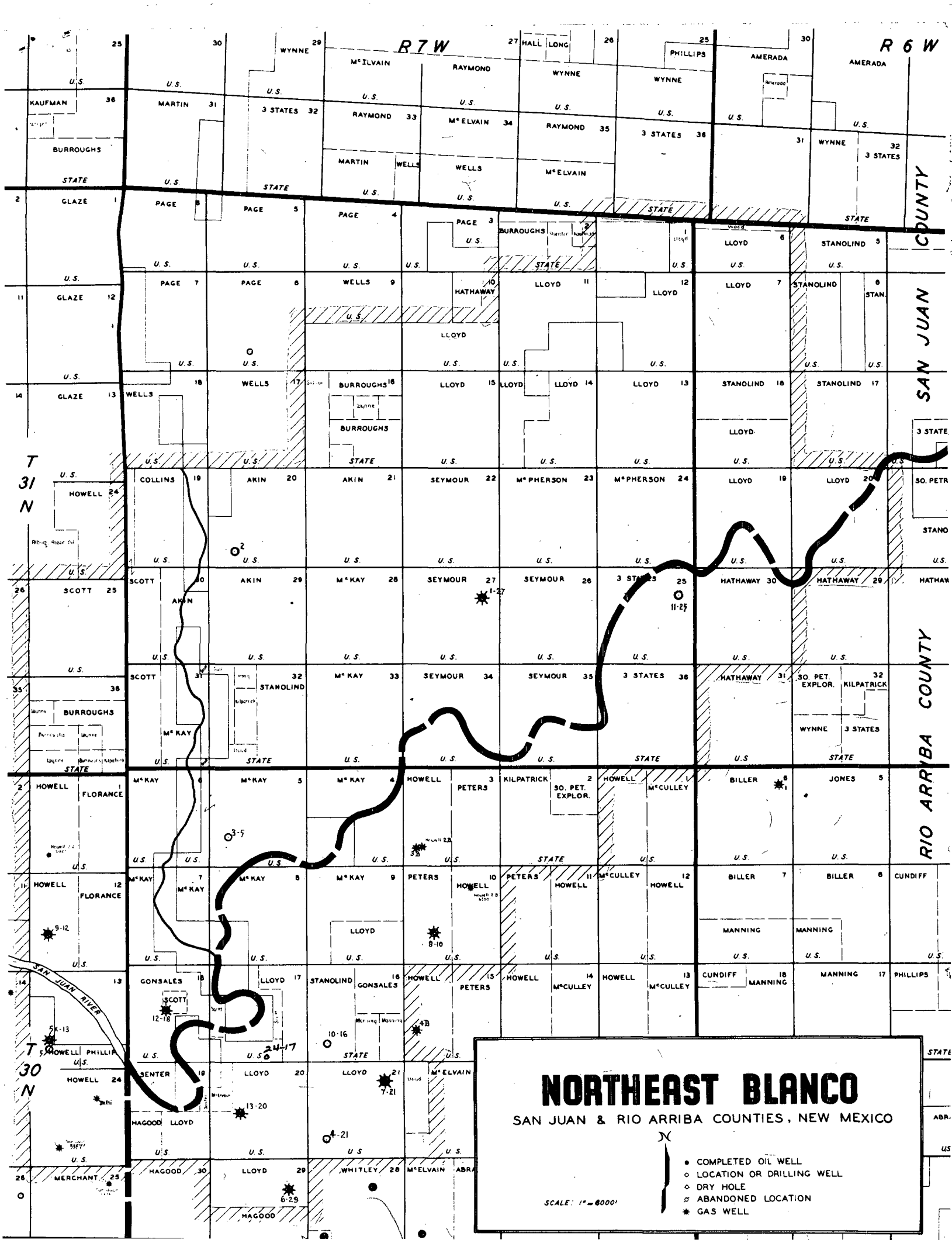
