Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Schultz-Payne Well No. 4-14, to be located 2450 feet from the South line and 2240 feet from the West line of Section 14, Township 25 North, Range 8 West, Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox location is based upon topographic conditions in the SW/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as you enclosed waivers from the offset operators agreeing to the formation of the proposed unit, it is possible for immediate approval
