Dear Mr. Macey:

As operator of the Northeast Blanco Unit, we request permission to drill an unorthodox well, to be located 1720' from the North line and 1940' from the East line of Section 36, T 31 N, R 8 W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The difficult topography prevents a normal well location for this well and it is, therefore, necessary to select a more suitable location for a drilling site.

Section 36, T 31 N, R 8 W, is a part of the Northeast Blanco Unit and the new location, as requested, will present no drainage problem to offset operations.


