Administrative Order NSL - 79

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your C. B. McElvain Government Well No. 1, to be located 1500 feet from the North line and 225 feet from the West line and in the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 23, Township 21 North, Range 2 West, Wildcat Pool, Sandoval County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NW/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as there are no other offset operators, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 104 (f) of the Statewide Rules and Regulations, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 104 (b) (2) of the Statewide Rules and Regulations for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey.
