Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Northeast Blanco Unit Well No. 49-30 to be located 1780 feet from the North line and 220 feet from the East line and in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 30, Township 31 North, Range 7 West, Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NE/4 of said section.
