*Amended Administrative Order NSL-103*

Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application of January 15, 1990 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Klein "A" Well No. 1 located at a previously approved unorthodox gas well location in the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool (NSL-103) 620 feet from the North line and 1400 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 31, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The E/2 of said Section 31 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.

Division Administrative Order NSL-103, dated April 29, 1957, shall be placed in abeyance until further notice.
