
This is to request administrative approval of an unorthodox location to be dually completed in the Blanco Mesa Verde and South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Extension Pools.

The well, our Florance 4-C (PM), is to be located 1600 feet from the South line and 2161 feet from the West line of Section 29, Township 28 North, Range 8 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico. The W/2 of Section 29 is dedicated to the Mesa Verde formation and the SW/4 of Section 29 is dedicated to the Pictured Cliffs formation. The major portion of the SW/4 consists of a high ridge and rocky bluffs. The location has been placed on the banks of a dry wash since the cost of an orthodox location would be extremely expensive.

El Paso Natural Gas Company holds the lease in the SE/4, therefore; the approval of other operators has not been sought.

I am enclosing two copies of the Certified Well Location Plat and two copies of our Intention to Drill.

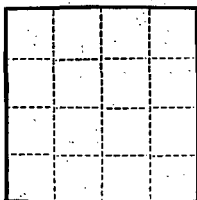

DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill & dual complete a well in the Pictured Cliffs formation & Mesa Verde formation. Mud circulation will be used thru the Pictured Cliffs formation & set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used thru the Mesa Verde & a production liner will be set. Possible productive intervals will be perforated & fractured. Estimated Total Depth 4735'.

Casing Program:

10-3/4" at 170' with 125 sacks cement circulated to the surface.

7-5/8" at 2380' with 250 sacks cement.

5-1/2" liner at 4735' with 300 sacks cement.

The W/2 of Section 29 is dedicated to the Mesa Verde.

The SW/4 of Section 29 is dedicated to the Pictured Cliffs.

W/2 and SW/4 Section 29 NM 03549.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

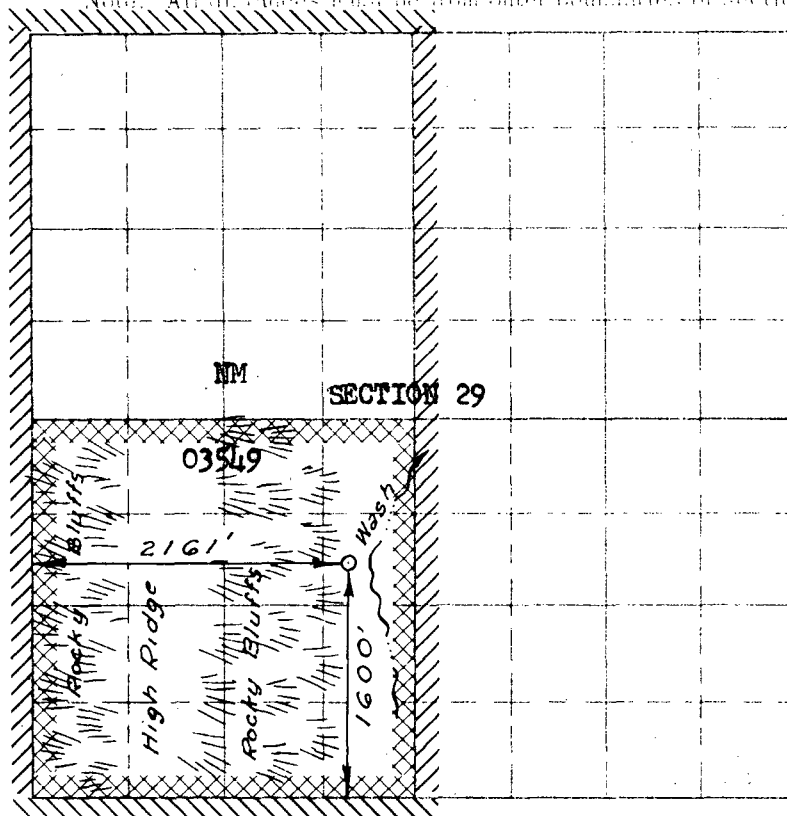
