Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your San Juan 32-9 Unit, Well No. 50, to be located 550 feet from the North line and 1150 feet from the East line and in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 25, Township 32 North, Range 10 West, Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NE/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as there are no other effected offset operators it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Section 1 (c) of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-110 as amended by Order R-397, you are hereby granted an exception to Section 1 (c) of Order R-110 for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey.
