Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Jicarilla Tribal 35-A Well No. 1 to be located 1650 feet from the South line and 1145 feet from the West line and in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 35, Township 25 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Otero-Gallup Pool extension, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NW/4 SW/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as you own all the offset acreage, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 104 (f) of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 104 (c) of said Rules and Regulations for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey.
