Gentlemen!

Commission grant this application of The Onio for authority to dually complete its State McDonald A/C 2 Well No. II, located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 13, T-22-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, now producing oil from the Arrowheed Oil Pool. The Ohio desires to dually complete this well in the Eumont Gas Pool in such a manner as to produce gas through the annulus between the casing and tubing and to continue producing oil from the Arrowheed Oil Pool through the tubing. The Ohio intends to install an efficient packer between the two zones and to perform the completion so as to prevent easie in each reservoir. A schematic diagram showing the proposed method the dual completion is attached. Subsequent to the completion of the work, the Ohio will present to the Commission data showing the detail completion program as well as plans for future testing which will be made regularly to determine that waste is not occurring in either reservoir.

The Onto further respectfully requests that; contingent upon the success of the proposed dual completion, the Commission cancer the 640-acres Eugent Gas Proration Unit (Section 15, T-22-S, R-36-E) presently assigned to our State McDonald A/C 2 Well No. 26 and subdivide said 540 acres into two non-standard Gas Proration Units as described below:

A 160-acre non-standard Gas Proration Unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the NE/4 of Section 13, T-22-5, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, on which is located the State McDonald A/C 2 Well No. II which we are proposing to dual with the present Arrowhead Oli Zone. This well is located 330 feet from the north and east lines of Section 13, and was completed in the Arrowhead Oil Pool prior to the effective date of Order R-520 in Case No. 673.

A 480-acre non-standard Gas Proration Unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the NW/4 and S/2 of Section 13, T-22-5, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, on which is located the State McDonald A/C 2 Well No. 26, which is presently a gas well in the Eumont Gas Pool with a 640-acre Standard Gas Proration Unit assigned to it. This well is located 1980 feet from the south and east lines of Section 13.

Approval of the focation of each of the wells for the purpose of production from the respective units described above is also requested.

The Onio owns the oil and gas leasehold estate on the acreage included in the proposed units and the two wells which age described above. The entire acreage covered by these two proposed units falls within the limits of the Europe Gas Pool and is reasonably presumed to be productive of gas from that pool.

Unless the proposed dual completion, well locations and revision of promation units are approved. The Ohlo will be deprived of a rain opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the natural gas in the Eumont Cas Pool. Our Well No. it was selected for this proposed dual completion because it is the highest well structurally in the NE/4 of Section 13, and it is the only well that contains large enough casing (7" O.O.) to permit the running of enotacesing string inside of it. The proposed completion in the Eumont Gas Zone will increase the life of this well to an extent where the life of the present casing may be exceeded. The use of Well No. It will permit us to remedy this situation, it it should occur. The granting of the relief sought by this application will protect correlative rights and will not cause, but will prevent was a

A plat is attached hereto which indicates the location of the proposed units, the wells, and the location of the surrounding tracts. A copy of this application with diagram and plat attached has been sent by registered mail to each of the operators named on the attached list.

The Onlo therefore requests that the Commission grant the necessary entherity for the dual completion and, contingent upon successful dual completion of Well No. II, that the Commission approve the location of the wells, cancel the existing standard unit and create the two non-standard proration units as described above, all without further motics or hearing and pursuant to the provisions of the applicable rules and regulations.

Reference is hereby made to your application dated June 25, 1999. Marathon Oil Company ("Marathon") is hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Eumont Gas Pool production to the previously approved non-standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") comprising the NE/4 of Section 13, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (see Division Administrative Order NSP-439, dated August 19, 1958), from the two following described wells:

- the original McDonald State "A/C-2" Well No. 11 (API No. 30-025-08897) located at an unorthodox gas well location 330 feet from the North and East lines (Unit A) of Section 13 (approved by Division Administrative Order NSL-160, dated August 28, 1958); and
- the existing McDonald State "A/C-2" Well No. 31 (API No. 30-025-25932), recently recompleted up-hole from the Drinkard Pool and located at a standard gas well location 1800 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the East line (Unit G) of Section 13.

Marathon is permitted to produce the allowable assigned this non-standard 160-acre unit from both wells in any proportion.
