Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your W. A. Ramsay "A" Well No. 20, located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line and in the NW/4 of Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is occasioned by the recompletion of a well previously drilled to another horizon.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 3 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 2 of Order R-520 for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
