Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your D. A. Williamson Well No. 1 located 660 feet from the North line and 760 feet from the East line and in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 23, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Tubb and Blinbry Gas Pools, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 3 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Tubb and Blinbry Gas Pools, as set forth in Orders R-586 and R-610, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 2 of Orders R-586 and R-610 for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
