

Dear Mr. Porter:

Pursuant to Rule 4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool under Order No. R-565-C, Aztec Oil & Gas Company (hereinafter referred to as "Applicant") hereby submits its application for an exception to the well location regulations of Rule 3 of said regulations. In support of this request for a nonstandard location, Applicant respectfully states and shows the following:

1.

Applicant's McClanahan No. 10 Well is presently located one thousand nine hundred and eighty feet (1980') from the West line and nine hundred and ninety feet (990') from the North line of Section 24, Township 28 North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico. This non-standard location is occasioned by the extreme topographic conditions which make it impossible to drill the well on a standard location.

2.

So far as is known to Applicant, El Paso Natural Gas Company, with offices at the El Paso Natural Gas Building, El Paso, Texas, is the only operator owning a lease offsetting the drilling unit for this non-standard location. Such operator has been furnished a copy of this application by registered mail, and has been requested Mr. A. L. Porter Page #2 June 9, 1959

to submit its approval directly to the Commission in order to expedite approval of this application.

3.

The McClanahan No. 10 Well was completed by Applicant as a producer of natural gas in paying quantities on May 16, 1959. At the time of drilling the McClanahan No. 10 Well, Applicant erroneously failed to submit its application for a non-standard location.

4.

Attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is a plat indicating the nonstandard location on the drilling unit, together with the names of the operators of all offsetting leases.

5.

Attached hereto as Exhibit "B" is a copy of NMOCC Form 128 submitted to the United States Geological Survey on April 1, 1959 by Applicant and approved by that office on April 3, 1959. This Exhibit "B" sets forth the extreme topographic conditions necessitating this non-standard location.

6.

This non-standard location has been drilled upon United States Oil and Gas Lease Serial No. SF-079634, and a copy of this application has been mailed to the United States Geological Survey, Farmington, New Mexico, attention of Mr. Phil McGrath.

WHEREFORE, Aztec Oil & Gas Company respectfully requests that the Secretary-Director of the Commission, by administrative approval, grant an exception to Rule 3 of Order No. R-565-C pertaining to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, without notice and hearing, approving the non-standard location set forth above.


