Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Vinson-Ramsay "A" Well No. 2 located 1980 (eet from the North line and 330 feet from the East line and in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 12, Township 26 South, Range 36 East. Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is occasioned by the recompletion of a well previously drilled to another horizon.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 3 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Jalmat Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 2 of Order R-520 for the above described unorthodox well location.
