Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Vaughn Well No. 4 (PC) to be located 1306 feet from the South line and 2000 feet from the East line of Section 29. Township 26 North, Range 6 West, South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs and undesignated Chacra Pools, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
