Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for a well to be drilled 790 feet from the North line and 750 feet from the East line and in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 3, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 3.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 104 (f) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 104 (b) (2) of the Commission Rules and Regulations for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
