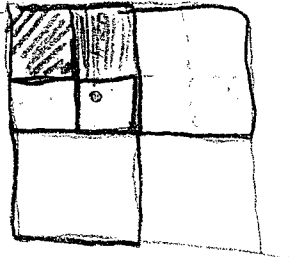
Tennessee Gas Transmission Company is co-owner and operator of the USA Glenn H. Callow Lease in San Juan County, New Mexico. This lease consists of all except the NE/4 of NW/4 of Section 27, all of Section 28 and the N/2 of Section 33, Township 29 North, Range 13 West.

Because of a misinterpretation of the spacing rules the location for USA Glenn H. Callow #11 has been staked for a Gallup-Dakota dual test, 1520 feet from the north line and 1520 feet from the west line of Section 28 of the above described lease. This location is orthodox for the Dakota zone which we expect to be gas productive but unorthodox for the Gallup zone which should be oil productive. This location was staked at this point partly, but not entirely, because of extreme topographic conditions. The above described location is on a Federal lease and has been approved by the USGS.

Tennessee Gas Transmission Company requests that this matter be scheduled for consideration at the earliest possible time. Approval of this location will not cause waste or impair correlative rights as the ownership interests of all 40 acre offset units are identical.
