Gentlemen:

Sinclair Oil & Gas Company hereby makes application for an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit and for an unorthodox location for our R. L. Brunson Well No. 7 in the Blinsbry Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. This well is located 700' from the South line and 515' from the West line of the West half of the Southeast quarter of Section 4, T-22S, R-37E.

With regard to the non-standard gas proration unit, the following information is submitted:

(1) The non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter quarter sections and lies wholly within a single governmental quarter section. (See attached ownership plat.)

(2) The entire non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas from the Blinsbry Gas Pool as evidenced by the offset development.

(3) All offset operators owning interests in the same quarter section or within 1980' of the well have been notified of this application this date by copy thereof by registered mail. In an effort to expedite this request, waivers are being requested from said operators; however, in the event that said waivers are not filed prior to the expiration of 30 days, it is requested that the Commission grant this application under the provisions of Paragraph 7, Rule 5 (C).

With respect to the unorthodox well location, the following information is submitted:

(1) The necessity for the unorthodox location is occasioned by the dual completion of an existing well that was originally completed August 1, 1947, as an oil well in the Drinkard Oil Pool.
