Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox oil well location for your Navajo Tribal E NBR Well No. 4 to be located 1115 feet from the North line and 2125 feet from the West line of Section 21, Township 29 North, Range 14 West, Undesignated Gallup Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 104 (f) of the Statewide Rules and Regulations, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 104 (b) (1) for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
