Dear Mr. Porter:

Pursuant to Rule 3 of Order R-1670-C, Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits, in triplicate, its application for administrative approval of an exception to the well location regulations set forth in said Order and requests administrative approval of an unorthodox drilling location in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, T-29-N, R-13-W, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.

In support of this application, Applicant respectfully states and shows the following:

1. The proposed unorthodox drilling location has been staked six hundred and sixty feet (660') from the South line and six hundred and sixty feet (660') from the West line of Section 20. Elliott, Inc., Tenneco Corporation, Texaco, Inc. and John J. Redfern, Jr. are the only operators of offsetting leases, or leases within the Section, as indicated on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, and have been furnished a copy of this application by certified mail, along with a request that they waive notice and hearing and consent to such unorthodox location.

2. This application was originally made and drilling was commenced for the purpose of completing the Hagood #22-G as a producing well in the Gallup sand as an extension to the Totah-Gallup Oil Pool. The location is not unorthodox with respect to the pool rules in effect for the Totah-Gallup Oil Pool and is within one (1) mile of the designated pool limits.

It is Applicant's belief that the Dakota formation may not be productive in this area, and for that reason wishes to minimize its risk in drilling a test well to the Dakota formation by testing the deeper zone at a location which would be orthodox should the well be plugged-back and completed in the Totah-Gallup Oil Pool. In addition, should a completion be made in the Gallup producing formation, the location should also be consistent with the drilling pattern previously established in the development of this oil pool.

Applicant respectfully requests that the Secretary-Director of the Commission, by administrative approval, grant an exception, as above provided, without notice and hearing, approving the unorthodox drilling location described above.

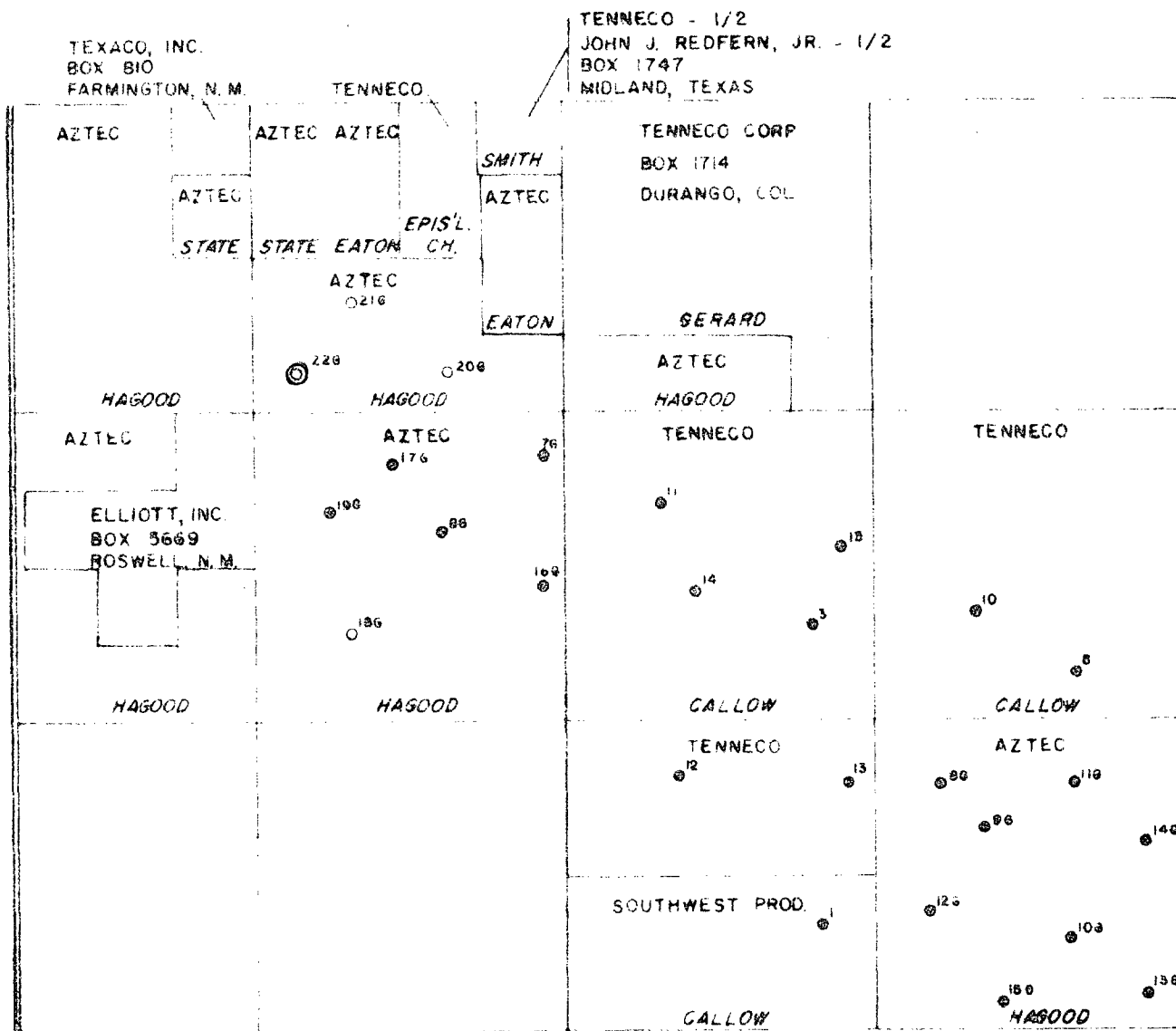


