Gentlemen:

We respectfully request your approval of a non-standard location of our Sanastee test which we propose to locate 510' FWL and 100' FSL, Section 35, T-32N, R-16W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

This request is based upon the severe topographic conditions in the immediate area. Any other location within the SW SW of Section 35 lies on the side of the mesa which is plunging off to the southwest at very steep angle making the cost of a standard location completely prohibitive.

For your reference, we are enclosing a plat illustrating the lease ownership in the immediate area, a survey plat with the approximate topographic relief sketched in, and a copy of our communication from Pan American Petroleum Corporation acknowledging their approval of the requested location.

In order to comply with our agreements relative to this test, it is imperative that we begin as soon as possible, we therefore request your reply by collect telegram.

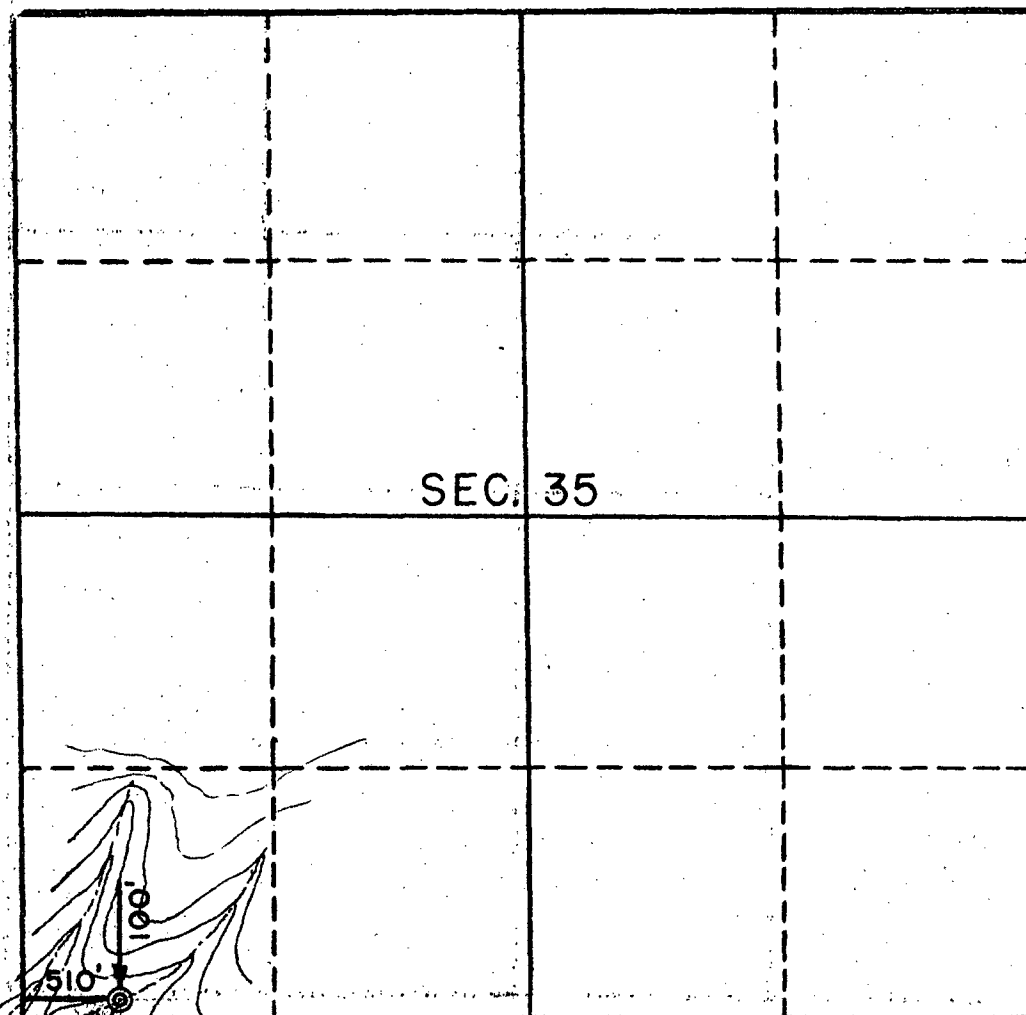

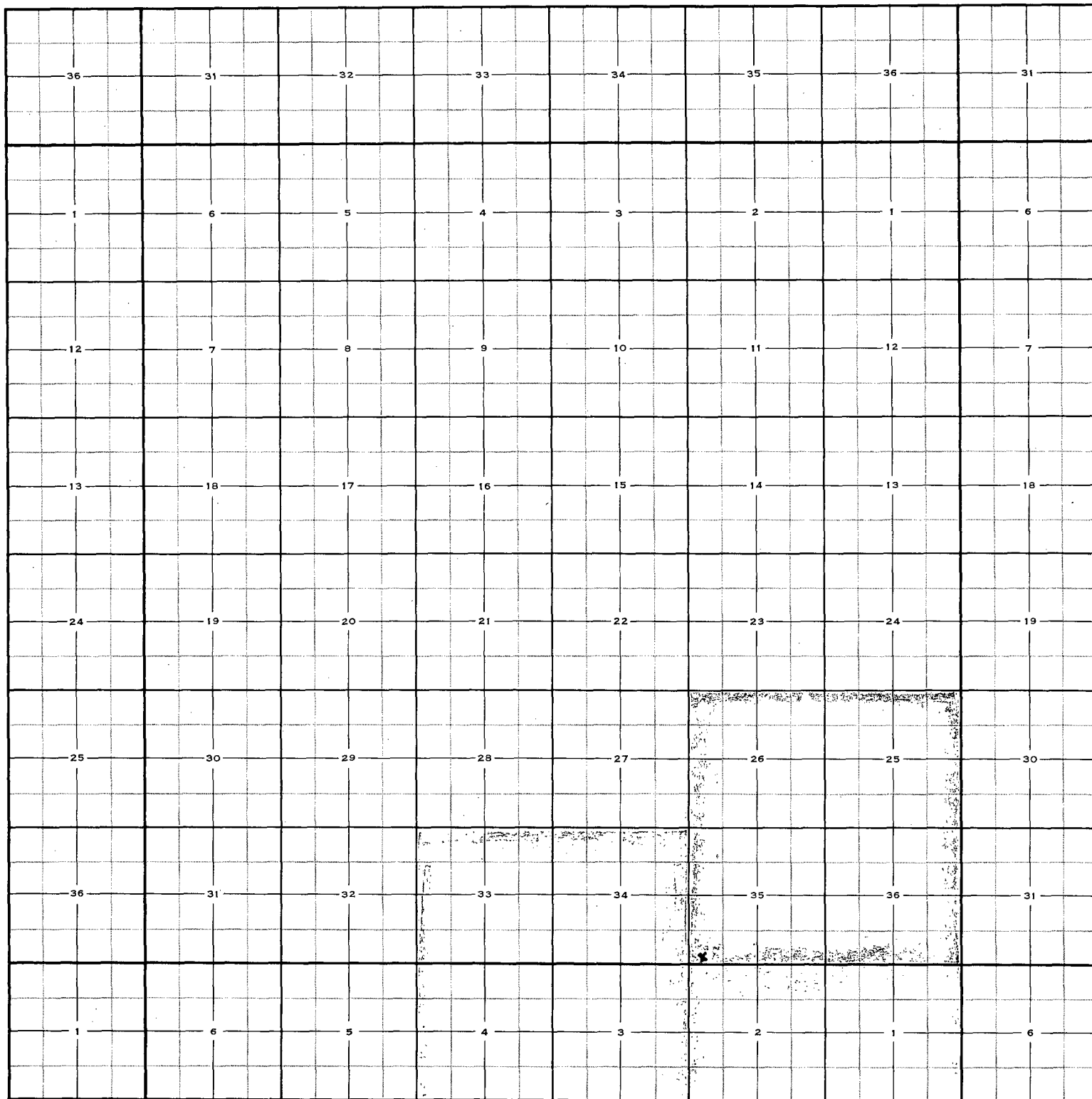
