Dear Ms. Dinning:

Reference is made to your request received by the Division on January 16, 2007, to increase the surface injection pressure on the Pretty Lady 30 11 34 Well No. 1. This request is based on a step rate test recently conducted on the well. The results of the step rate test show that an increase in the surface injection pressure for this well is justified and will not result in the fracturing of the injection formation and confining strata.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:
