Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of four unorthodox locations for injection wells in the Red Mountain Oil Pool, McKinley County, New Mexico. Your proposed locations are as follows:

- Well No. I-16, 945 feet from the South line, 2590 feet from the East line, Section 20;
- Well No. I-17, 442 feet from the South line, 2430 feet from the West line, Section 20;
- Well No. I-18, 90 feet from the North line, 2410 feet from the West line, Section 29; and
- Well No. I-19, 730 feet from the North line, 2505 feet from the West line, Section 29;

all in Township 20 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, McKinley County, New Mexico.

Pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph 2 of Order No. R-1533, the above-described unorthodox locations for injection wells in the Red Mountain Oil Pool are hereby approved.
