

I have investigated terrain conditions in the above 40 acres and believe that the non-standard location is justified, particularly due to the fact that the offsetting acreage is also owned by Bolack, Greer, et al.

We will require that a deviation test be filed and also in the event that the deviation tests indicate the possibility of the well bottoming off of the unit we will insist on a directional survey. I recommend that the non-standard location be approved.


