Gentlemen:

Shell Oil Company, because of topographical conditions, requests an exception to Rule 104 for administrative approval to drill a 3500-foot Abo wildcat 1170' FNL & 660' FEL of Section 35-22S-21E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

As can be seen on the attached sketch showing surface topography, any standard location in the NE/4 NE/4 Section 35 would fall on the side of a steep mountain. The estimated cost to build a road and drill site at a standard location is estimated to be approximately \$25,000 more than that required for the proposed unorthodox location which is in a valley and near an existing road.

Mr. M. L. Armstrong, Supervisor of your Artesia office, examined the proposed location and surrounding terrain on April 18, 1963.

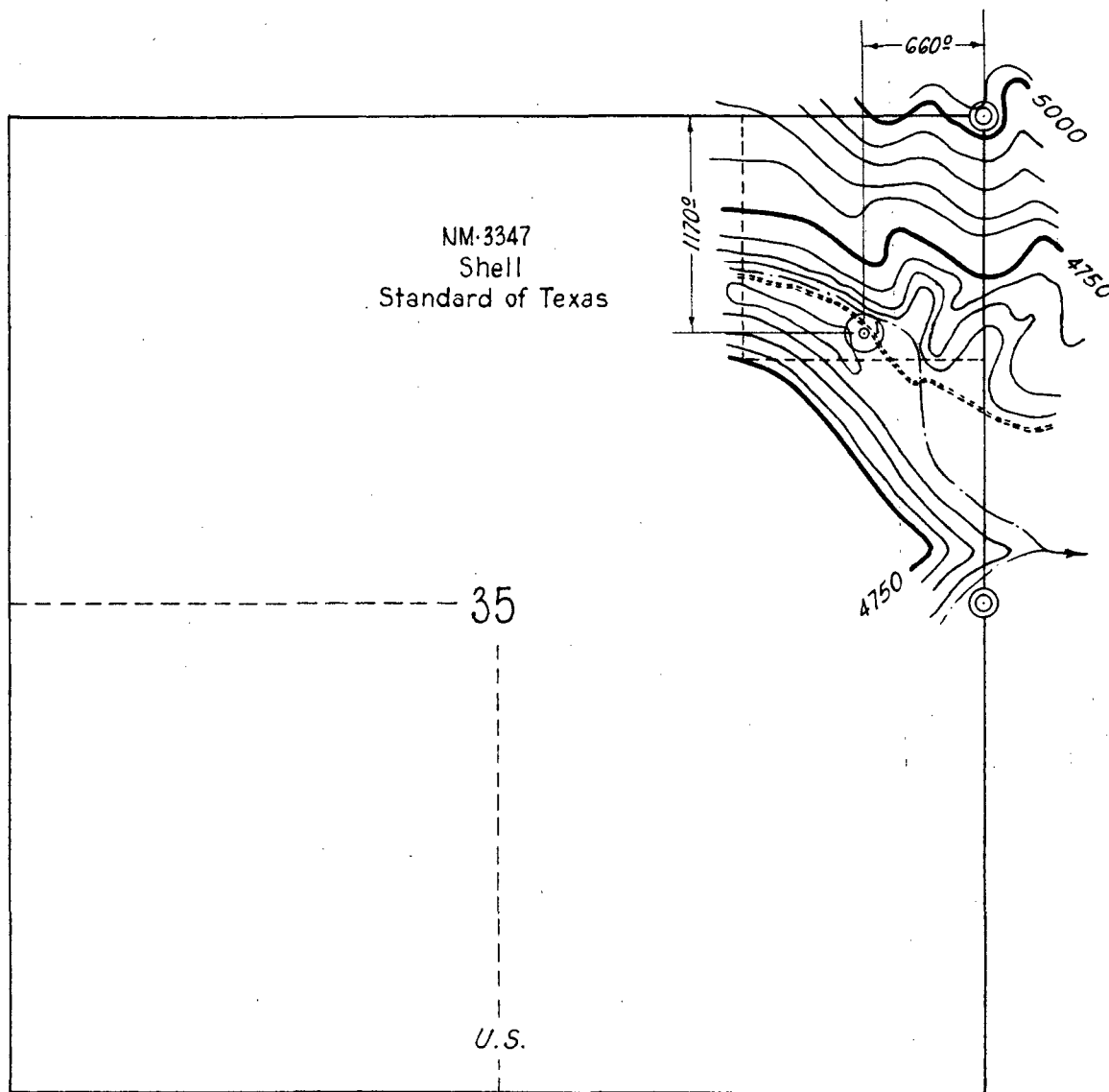
