Texaco plans to begin in the near future drilling a gas well whose objective horizon is the Dakota gas pool.
- Due to extremely rough terrain, it will be impossible for the applicant to drill said well at the orthodox location, to-wit: 790 feet from the boundary line of the proration unit and no nearer than 130 feet to a Governmental quarter quarter section line or subdivision inner boundary line. The closest location to said orthodox location where the terrain permits drilling is 1,022 feet from the north line and 220 feet from the east line of Section 15, Township 28 North, Range 13 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.
