Reference is made to your application dated January 15, 1991, for a non-standard South Corbin Wolfcamp oil well location for your existing Uncle Com Well No. 1 which was drilled in 1965 and completed in the South Corbin Morrow Gas Pool at a previously approved unorthodox gas well location (Division Administrative Order NSL-375, dated April 19, 1966) 660 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 28, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Morrow zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the South Corbin Wolfcamp Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the South Corbin Wolfcamp Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8181-B, is unorthodox. Further, the N/2 NW/4 of said Section 28 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 of said Division Order No. R-8181-B, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.

Further, the provisions of Division Administrative Order NSL-375 shall be placed in abeyance until further notice.
