Gentlemen:

We are enclosing Form C-102: "Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat", showing an unorthodox location for the referenced well. The regular location was moved because of excessive surface erosions inside the 150-foot quarter-quarter tolerance allowance in the Flying "M" Field and is now located 990' FWL and 2310' FNL of Section 19, T-9-S, R-33-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

We are formally applying for an exception to Specific Oil Conservation Commission Order R 3228, "Acreage and Well Location Requirements for Development Wells, Flying "M" (Penn.) Field, Lea County, New Mexico", on the basis of adverse surface conditions. 
