Dear Mr. Porter:

On behalf of Ralph Nix, I request administrative approval for an exception to the well location requirements of Rule 104 of the Oil Conservation Commission to permit the re-entry into the plugged and abandoned well located 2,360 feet from the south line and 245 feet from the east line of Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. It is proposed to re-enter this well as the Ralph Nix-Signal No. 3 well and to drill the same to a total depth of approximately 2,300 feet below the surface.

In support of this request, I enclose:

1. Original and one copy of well location and acreage dedication plat, Commission Form C-102.
2. Original and copy of map showing location of producers, injection wells and plugged and abandoned wells in the applicable portions of Sections 17 and 18, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M.
3. Original letter dated December 17, 1969, reflecting the consent on January 7, 1970, of Gulf Oil Corporation to the unorthodox location.
4. Original letter dated December 26, 1969, reflecting the consent on December 19, 1969, of Cima Capitan, Inc. to the unorthodox location.




Dear Mr. Fugua:
