Wood, McShane & Thams-Colorado just recently drilled and completed New Mexico "M" State No. 59, which was the second well of a series in a planned drilling program of wells on non-standard location. New Mexico "M" State No. 59 is located 1240 feet from the North line and 1340 feet from the East line of Section 30, Township 22-S, Range 37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

A Non-Standard Location Order was not obtained for "M" State No. 59 due to the fact that I was not aware of the requirement. I was advised through a telephone conversation to apply for a Non-Standard Location Order and thus the reason for this letter.

Wood, McShane & Thams-Colorado's application to drill "M" State No. 63, their first unorthodox oil well location, was approved by Case No. 4288, Order No. R-3910.

It is desirable to drill "M" State No. 59 on a non-standard location, as pointed out in Case No. 4288, in order to convert from an eighty to a forty acre pattern which should substantially increase the secondary recovery from this project.
