Dear Mr. Schorder:

Reference is made to Dawson Operating Company's application dated August 10, 1993 and to our telephone conversation on Tuesday, November 22, 1994, for a 160-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Undesignated Jalmat Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 30: NE/4

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your existing New Mexico "M" State Well No. 60 which was drilled in 1972 and completed in the Langlie-Mattix Pool at a previously approved unorthodox oil well location 1410 feet from the North line and 90 feet from the East line (Unit H) of said Section 30 (see Division Administrative Order NSL-529, as amended.)


It is my understanding that the Langlie-Mattix zone has been plugged back and said well has been recompleted up-hole to the Undesignated Jalmat Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for both pools as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, is unorthodox.

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By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(a)4 and 2(c) of said Special Rules and Regulations, the above non-standard gas spacing and proration unit is hereby approved.

Said Division Administrative Order NSL-529 shall be placed in abeyance until further notice.
