

RE: Unorthodox Gas Well Location - Yates Petroleum Corporation Nickson "BM" No. 2 Penasco Draw (S.A. Yeso) Eddy County, New Mexico

Dear Mr. Porter:

Under the provisions of OCC Order No. 4-4365, Case No. 4745. Administrative Approval of a non-standard gas well spacing is asked for our Nickson "BM" No. 2 located 330 feet from the North and East lines of Section 30-185-26E, Eddy County.

This well was being drilled for an oil completion in the Penasco Draw San Andres formation in December, 1972 when it blew out. The well was recently deepened to 1600', cased and perforated. We are now completing the well as a gas well with 320 acres dedicated as provided for in Order No. 4365, with a potential of 298 MCFPD and a GOR of 62,500/1.
